

CCAA Rainouts

The policy on rain and lightning is usually set by the pool management where you are. Typically if there is lightning in your immediate area you clear the pool. Then wait for 20 minutes. If the lightning stops, continue the meet. If you get any lightning during the 20 minutes, the clock starts over again. If you have to start and stop the meet more than 4 times, consider canceling the meet. The team coaches should get together at that point and determine what to do.

There is no meet make-up policy. Generally it is very difficult to make-up a missed meet.

The event schedule shows that if the meet is completed thru event 86, then the meet is official. If the meet is cancelled or does not reach event 86, the meet is a draw. This means that all teams tie for that meet. To speed up the meet in order to finish quickly, stop running the ribbon heats. When the meet is finished you can run the ribbon heats if time and weather permits.
